Farm Safety Note

Lift truck training. As a business owner / manager are you aware that regular refresher training is required for all your lift truck operators. The HSE advised period is 5 years as a maximum time but if you assess your operators driving habits, or they are involved in an accident, and you find problems or bad habits this period should be less or you may even conclude that refresher training is due immediately. It is normally a 1 day course and is very cost effective. With a very busy period coming up it could well be worth looking into this.

Talking of busy periods how is your First Aid cover on the farm. If you carry out a First Aid Risk

Assessment you will find that agriculture is in the medium to high risk category and that the minimum cover you require is for employees to be trained in Emergency First Aid at Work, which is a one day course, or possibly First Aid at Work which is a 3 day course. The use of the old style Appointed Persons no longer fulfils the requirements.

Do you have LGV drivers that are fully trained for the Driver CPC requirements? If not you only have until 9th September to complete the 35hrs (5 days) of training for this. There is a vast range of courses available for this, including lift truck and EFAW as above, which again are very cost effective.
