The nitrogen fertiliser market has been quiet with farmers contemplating the effect of lower crop prices and being busy with autumn work. There has probably been a feeling of if 'we hold off buying, the price will fall'.

However, the UK manufacturers have been exporting product to Europe removing any surplus. The concern is that there will be a major logistical problem getting product on to farm when farmers finally order months later than they would normally do. At the same time the producers are maintaining monthly increases of £3 - £5/t. The price of phosphate is under some pressure whilst potash prices are stable.
