MANAGERS' MESSAGE

October 2018

Most of us will reflect on this summer as being one of the kindest on record. An early start and settled weather gave us plenty of time to harvest crops and work the land down. Yields were typically less than we might have hoped for, but higher prices should make up for the shortfall. The lack of rain continues, having an effect on new plantings, cultivations and wheat drilling plans, but when is the weather ever just right for all of us! Inter member demand for contracting services suffered as a consequence of an easier season, but the spirit of co-operation delivered results where requests were made. Our major concern for this winter as temperatures drop is the waxing of gas oil and the serious disruption, cost and downtime it causes. The imminent introduction of higher inclusions of biofuel in the gas oil is likely to have an adverse effect on waxing points. Summer grade gas oil is supposed to wax at -4 degrees centigrade. However, this is a laboratory result and waxing may well occur at higher temperatures due to the moisture content in the fuel (tank hygiene), wind chill, fuel filter specification and condition. Winter grade gas oil which waxes at around -12 degrees, will be going onto farms from the 1st November. If you are carrying summer grade gas oil over into the winter period, you should consider adding an anti waxing additive, before it waxes. It will not unwax fuel. The other alternative is to have winter grade fuel in a separate tank, for winter use. Mixing winter grade and summer grade does not have the blending effect you would anticipate and is likely to lead to a higher waxing point than you expect. Draining the water off the bottom of gas oil tanks is a good practice. Summer grade fuel purchased before 1st November can be delivered with an anti waxing

WAXED GAS OIL

We are very concerned that changes to gas oil may result in the waxing point of gas oil rising. Summer grade gas oil is supposed to wax at -4 degrees and winter grade at -12 degrees. We would treat these figures as optimistic. Please see the Managers' message for more details. In summary:

- Summer grade gas oil used in the winter needs an anti wax additive
- Keep a separate tank for winter grade gas
- Drain water off the bottom of fuel tanks
- Position tanks and vehicles inside, out of the wind and off the floor
- Carry spare fuel filters in your stocks
- Drain/replace summer grade fuel from combines etc.
